<p style="text-align: center;"><b>TOURNAMENT RULES</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <u>State, Federal and Local Laws</u> must be obeyed.</li> <li>2. <u>Alcohol and Narcotics</u> will not be allowed in the possession of contestants during tournament hours, unless prescription medicine.</li> <li>3. <u>Courtesy, Safe Boating, Sportsmanship and Conservation</u> must be displayed at all times by contestants. A U.S. Coast Guard approved chest type PFD must be on and fastened anytime the combustion engine is running. All boats must meet U.S. Coast Guard standards. Outboard motors may not exceed boat manufacturer's rating. All boats must have an emergency kill-switch and must be attached to the driver during operation of combustion engine.</li> <li>4. <u>Boats must have</u> an operational live well with an aeration system. Teams may keep no more than <b>10</b> bass in the live well.</li> <li>5. <u>All fishing</u> must be done with artificial lures only. Pork is permitted. Only one rod and reel may be used at a time by contestants. No trolling with the combustion engine is allowed. All fish must be caught in a legal and sporting manner during tournament hours from tournament waters. Contestants may not use any communication or video device for the sole purpose of locating or catching bass during tournament hours.</li> <li>6. <u>Scoring</u> will be determined by the total weight of not more than <b>10</b> bass per boat caught by <u>either</u> member. Fish will be measured on a "<u>Golden Rule</u>" measuring board with the tail closed.</li> <li>7. <u>No fishing</u> is allowed within 25 yards of another tournament boat without mutual consent.</li> <li>8. <u>Trailer</u>ing to and from the weigh-in during tournament hours is allowed.</li> <li>9. <u>Penalties</u> There will be a 1 pound penalty deducted for each dead fish weighed-in.
